What is the Commonwealth Home Support Program?

The Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) is entry-level care for people who need a low level of support to keep them living well and independently. HSS can provide nursing services under CHSP, including medication management, wound management and continence management.

What is a Home Care Package?

Also designed to keep you well and living independently, a Home Care Package is for people with more complex care needs who require a coordinated approach to manage the delivery of the care. This ensures the right care and services are being provided so that your health and wellbeing goals are met.

There are four levels of care available, depending on your needs.


Our services include

- personal care
- domestic assistance
- shopping assistance
- transport assistance
- social support
- nursing care
- allied health, including physiotherapy, occupational therapy and podiatry
- equipment assistance
- home modifications

How can I access aged care at home?

To access Government subsidised aged care services, you will need to be registered with My Aged Care and undergo an assessment to find out if you are eligible for subsidised services. You can register and apply for an assessment by contacting My Aged Care on **1800 200 422** or through an online application myagedcare.gov.au/assessment/apply-online.

Once assessed, HSS can guide you through the process and provide information on fees and costs associated with each program.



How does it work?

The Australian Government subsidises the cost of care at home to keep you as healthy and safe as possible while living in the comfort of home.

HSS is approved by the Government to deliver Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) nursing services in metro South Australia, and Home Care Packages nationally.

If you are approved for subsidised care at home, HSS is here to support you.

By choosing HSS, you will have access to our team of nurse care coordinators who will provide as much assistance as you need and coordinate all aspects of your care requirements.

If you have not yet contacted My Aged Care, or if you are waiting for an assessment or approval, HSS may assist you under our self-funded program. Contact HSS and speak with one of our Care Coordination team to find out more.

Who provides the service?

Home Support Services (HSS) has been providing in-home healthcare services since 1989. We are committed to providing innovative programs which enable you to receive the care you need in the comfort of your own home.

HSS has been accredited to deliver services funded by the CHSP and Home Care Packages programs by the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission, the national regulator for aged care services.
